

LOVE PRAYER

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. There came a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to testify about the Light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the Light, but he came to testify about the Light. There was the true Light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.” –John 1:1-14 NASB

Jesus prayed to the Father: “Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name—the name you gave me—so that they may be one as we are one.” –John 17:11-12 NIV

Jesus said: “Again I say to you, that if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven. For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst.” –Matthew 18:19-20 NASB

Jesus said: “If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.” –Matthew 21:22 NASB

Jesus also said: “‘YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.’ This is the great and foremost commandment. The second is like it, ‘YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.’ On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.” –Matthew 22:36-40 NASB

Do you believe that Jesus is the Word of God, and that He is faithful and true?

According to His promise above, if two or more believers are gathered together and pray to the Father in His Holy Name, He will grant their request(s).

The Word also says it is true that the “whole Law and the Prophets” are summarized and fulfilled by loving the Lord with all our might, and loving everyone we meet just as we want to be loved.

Based upon these promises and truths, here is a Love Prayer to pray with one another:

“Heavenly Father, You said that when two or three are gathered in Your name, You are right here among us; and that if we agree upon anything together in prayer – and believe, it will be done for us.

“Father, we ask in the Name of Jesus Christ Your Son our Lord and Savior that You fill us always with the fullness of Your Love, so that we may love You forever with all of our might, loving everyone we meet each day just as we are loved by You. Amen.”
